

Types of Block Ice:

Solid Block: Best quality- water frozen into a block

Pressed Cube: Ice cubes pressed together with water filling the gaps and frozen to form a block. The quality is not nearly as good as a solid block because as the ice softens as you shave it can come apart...but it is definitely better than the third option:

Pressed Slurry: Slush frozen together. Avoid if possible! Worst quality of ice!
